IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

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To amend, on an temporary basis, the District of Columbia Comprehensive Plan Act of 1984 Land Use Element Amendment Act of 1984 to provide a 45-day extension to the Council’s period of review of the Southwest Neighborhood Plan.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “Extension of Review Period for the Southwest Small Area Plan Temporary Amendment Act of 2015”.

Sec. 2. Section 4(c) of the District of Columbia Comprehensive Plan Act of 1984 Land Use Element Amendment Act of 1984, effective March 16, 1985 (D.C. Law 5-187; D.C. Official Code § 1-306.03(c)), is amended by adding a new paragraph (4A) to read as follows:

“(4A) Notwithstanding paragraph (4) of this section, the Council review period for the Southwest Neighborhood Plan, transmitted by the Mayor on April 1, 2015 with the Southwest Neighborhood Plan Approval Resolution of 2015 (PR 21-127), is extended by an additional 45-days, excluding Saturdays, Sundays, legal holidays, and days of Council recess.”.

Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Council’s Budget Director as the fiscal impact statement required by section 602(c)(3) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(3)).

30 (a) This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by
31 the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review
32 as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
33 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
34 Columbia Register.

35 (b) This act shall expire after 225 days of its having taken effect.
