A BILL IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA To order the closing of a portion of a public alley system in Square 453, bounded by I Street, 7<sup>th</sup> Street, H Street, and 6th Street in Northwest Washington, DC, in Ward 2. Be IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act be cited as the "Closing of a Public Alley in Square 453, S.O. 14-17847, Act of 2015". Sec. 2. Pursuant to Section 201 of the Street and Alley Closing and Acquisition Procedures Act of 1982, effective March 10, 1983, (D.C. Law 4-201; D.C. Official Code §9-202.01), the Council of the District of Columbia finds the portion of the public alley system in Square 453, as shown on the Surveyor's plat in S.O. 14-17847, unnecessary for alley purposes and orders it closed with title to the land to vest as shown on the Surveyor's plat. Sec. 3. The closing of this public alley in section 2 of this act is contingent upon the recordation of a covenant establishing new portions of the alley system by easement as shown on the Surveyor's plat in S.O. 14-17847, and agreeing to maintain such new portions of the alley system established by easement. Sec. 4. The Secretary of the Council shall transmit a copy of this act, upon its effective

date, to the Office of the Surveyor of the District of Columbia.
