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A BILL

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IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

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To require the Department of Parks and Recreation to conduct a study to determine the feasibility of placing a recreation center at 4th Street and Chesapeake Street, S.E., in Ward 8, in the area for the proposed homeless shelter site.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “Recreation Center at 4th and Chesapeake Street Feasibility Study Act of 2016”.

Sec. 2. Feasibility study.

(a) The Department of Parks and Recreation (“Department”) shall conduct a study to determine the feasibility of placing a recreation center at 4th Street and Chesapeake Street, S.E., in Ward 8, in the area for the proposed homeless shelter site.

(b) The Department shall submit a copy of the feasibility study, along with its findings and recommendations to the Council and the Mayor by October 1, 2017.

Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

34           The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal  
35 impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975,  
36 approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

37           Sec. 4. Effective date.

38           This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the  
39 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as  
40 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December  
41 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of  
42 Columbia Register.
