21	for a person, without penalty, to adjudicate or pay a notice of infraction, renew the registration of
22	a vehicle, pass a vehicle inspection, and renew a noncommercial or commercial driver license,
23	provisional permit, or commercial learner permit to account for the closure of the District
24	government or the DMV due to an emergency, an administrative closure, or any other similar
25	closure.".
