21 To amend the Board of Ethics and Government Accountability Establishment and
22 Comprehensive Ethics Reform Amendment Act of 2011 to require lobbyists to file
23 monthly activity reports with the Director of Government Ethics.

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
25 act may be cited as the "Lobbyist Activity Reporting Transparency Amendment Act of 2017".

26 Sec. 2. Section 230(a) of Board of Ethics and Government Accountability Establishment
27 and Comprehensive Ethics Reform Amendment Act of 2011, effective April 27, 2012 (D.C. Law
28 19-124; D.C. Official Code § 1-1162.30(a)), is amended by striking the sentence "Each registrant
29 shall file with the Director of Government Ethics between the 1st and 10th day of July and
30 January of each year a report signed under oath concerning the registrant's lobbying activities
31 during the previous 6-month period." and inserting the sentence "Each registrant shall file with
32 the Director of Government Ethics each month a report signed under oath concerning the
33 registrant's lobbying activities during the previous month." in its place.

34 Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

35 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal
36 impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975,
37 approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

38 Sec. 4. Effective date.

39 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
40 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as
41 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
42 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
43 Columbia Register.
