A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To officially designate the alley in Square 1075 that runs east and west between the 400 blocks of 15th and 16th Streets, S.E., and the 1500 blocks of D and E Streets, S.E., in Ward 6, as Duvall Court.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “Duvall Court Designation Act of 2017”.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to the Street and Alley Closing and Acquisition Procedures Act of 1982, effective March 10, 1983 (D.C. Law 4-201; D.C. Official Code § 9-204.01 *et seq.*), the Council officially designates the alley in Square 1075 east and west between the 400 blocks of 15th and 16th Streets, S.E., and the 1500 blocks of D and E Streets, S.E., in Ward 6, as “Duvall Court” in recognition of J.H. Duvall, the builder who constructed the original alley dwellings in Square 1075.

Sec. 3. Transmittal.

The Council shall transmit a copy of this act, upon its effective date, to the Mayor, the District Department of Transportation, and the Office of the Surveyor.

Sec. 4. Fiscal impact statement.

35 Sec. 5. Effective date.

36 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
37 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as
38 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
39 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
40 Columbia Register.

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
