

A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To amend Chapter 20 of Title 47 of the District of Columbia Official Code to eliminate the sales tax charged for health-club services.

BE IT ENACTED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "Tax on Wellness Repeal Act of 2017".

Sec. 2 Section 47-2001(N)(1)(Y) is amended to read as follows:

"(Y)(i) The sale of or charge for a tanning studio;"

(ii) For the purposes of this subparagraph, the term "tanning studio" means a business the purpose of which is to provide individuals a manmade tan, including sun tanning salons and spray tanning salons;".

Sec. 3. Applicability.

(a) This act shall apply upon the date of inclusion of its fiscal effect in an approved budget and financial plan.

(b) The Chief Financial Officer shall certify the date of the inclusion of the fiscal effect in an approved budget and financial plan, and provide notice to the Budget Director of the Council of the certification.

(c)(1) The Budget Director shall cause the notice of the certification to be published in

1 the District of Columbia Register.

2 (2) The date of publication of the notice of the certification shall not affect the  
3 applicability of this act.

4 Sec. 4. Fiscal impact statement

5 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal  
6 impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975,  
7 approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

8 Sec. 5. Effective date.

9 The act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by  
10 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as  
11 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December  
12 24, 1973, (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of  
13 Columbia Register.
