29 IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

34 To amend the Housing Production Trust Fund Act of 1988 to provide the Mayor with authority
35 to issue solicitations up to one fiscal year in advance for the tax revenue that is dedicated
36 to the Trust Fund.

38 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, that this
39 act may be cited as the "Housing Production Trust Fund Advanced Solicitations Amendment Act
40 of 2017"

41 Sec. 2. Section 3 of the Housing Production Trust Fund Act of 1989, effective March 16,
42 1989 (D.C. Law 7-202; D.C. Official Code § 42-2802), is amended by adding a new subsection
43 (e) to read as follows:

44 “(e) In the fiscal year prior to a fiscal year in which Fund dedicated tax revenues will be
45 collected, available, and not otherwise committed and appropriated, the Department is authorized
46 to solicit proposals and rank recipients in funding order for the expenditure of those tax revenues
47 that will be dedicated to the Fund in the next fiscal year that are not committed for other
48 purposes and are certified in the approved financial plan for the next fiscal year; provided, that
49 no contractual agreements, obligations, or commitments to provide funding may be made or
50 executed until the fiscal year in which the funds are available and appropriated;”.

51 Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

52 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal
53 impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975,
54 approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

55 Sec. 4. Effective date.

56 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
57 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as
58 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
59 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
60 Columbia Register.
