COUNCIL PROPOSAL. Sec. 101. Pursuant to section 401(2) of the Street and Alley Closing and Acquisition 22 Procedures Act of 1982, effective March 10, 1983 (D.C. Law 4-201; D.C. Official Code § 9-23 204.01(2)) ("Act") and in accordance with section 401(3) and (4) of the Act, the Council 24 proposes that a statue of Charles Hamilton Houston be commissioned to honor a remarkable 25 native Washingtonian and champion of civil rights who, as a brilliant lawyer, tenacious Dean of 26 Howard University Law School, and the first special counsel for the NAACP, laid the legal 27 foundation responsible for dismantling the American system of segregation. He left an indelible 28 mark on society and inspired generations of lawyers to pursue the cause of freedom and equal 29

Effective date. 65 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the 66 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as 67 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 68 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of 69 70 Columbia Register.
