

5 A BILL
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8 IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

11 To amend the Advisory Neighborhood Councils Act of 1975 to require that any candidate for
12 Advisory Neighborhood Commissioner must provide documentation verifying residency
13 within the relevant single-member district as a precondition to ballot eligibility.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
15 act may be cited as the “Advisory Neighborhood Commission Candidate Proof of Residence
16 Amendment Act of 2017”.

17 Sec. 2. Section 6(a) of the Advisory Neighborhood Councils Act of 1975, effective
18 October 10, 1975 (D.C. Law 1-21; D.C. Official Code § 1-309.05(a)), is amended as follows:

19 (1) A new paragraph (3) is added to read as follows:

20 “(3) As proof of residency, a candidate shall file with the Board of Elections any
21 two of the following that reflect the candidate’s name and current address:

22 “(A) A valid District driver’s license or nondriver’s identification;

23 “(B) A utility bill, except for a disconnect notice, dated within the
24 preceding 60 days;

25 “(C) A telephone bill, except for disconnect notice, dated within the
26 preceding 60 days;

27 “(D) A deed, mortgage, or settlement agreement executed within the
28 preceding 60 days;

29 “(E) An unexpired lease or rental agreement with the name of the
30 candidate listed as the lessee, permitted resident, or renter. The unexpired lease or rental
31 agreement must be signed by all parties;

32 “(F) A District property tax bill or tax assessment dated within the
33 preceding 60 days;

34 “(G) An unexpired homeowner’s or renter’s insurance policy;

35 “(H) A letter from the Court Services and Offender Supervision Agency or
36 the Department of Corrections dated within the preceding 60 days;

37 “(I) A bank, credit union, credit card, investment account, or home equity
38 line of credit statement dated within the preceding 60 days;

39 “(J) Official mail received from a District or federal government agency
40 including contents and envelope, postmarked within the preceding 60 days;

41 “(K) A medical bill dated within the preceding 60 days;

42 “(L) A student, automobile, or personal loan statement dated within the
43 preceding 60 days; or

45 “(M) A home security system bill dated within the preceding 60 days.”.

46 Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

47 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal
48 impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975,
49 approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

50 Sec. 4. Effective date.

51 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
52 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as
53 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
54 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
55 Columbia Register.
