**A BILL**

**IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA**

---

To approve, on an emergency basis, the award of an Agreement to Enter into a Long Term Subsidy Contract (“ALTSC”) for a Multiyear Term of Fifteen (15) Years in support of the District’s Local Rent Supplement Program (“LRSP”) to fund housing costs associated with affordable housing units for Contract No. 2014-LRSP-08A with HELP Washington DC LP for LRSP units at HELP Walter Reed, located at 6900 Georgia Avenue, NW Washington, DC 20037, and to authorize payment for housing services received under such contract.

BE IT ENACTED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “Local Rent Supplement Program Contract No. 2014-LRSP-08A Approval and Authorization Emergency Act of 2017”.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 451 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51), and section 202 of the Procurement Practices Reform Act of 2010, effective April 8, 2011 (D.C. Law 18-371; D.C. Official Code § 2-352.02), the Council approves the ALTSC with HELP Washington DC LP to provide operating subsidy in support of 6 affordable housing units in an initial amount not to exceed \$1,046,700 annually.

Sec. 3. The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Chief Financial Officer as required by section 602(c)(3) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Code § 1-206.02(c)(3)).

1           Sec. 4. This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the  
2 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for no longer than 90 days,  
3 as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in section 412(a) of the District  
4 of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 2973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)).
