

7 AN ACT

12 IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

17 To amend, on an temporary basis, the District of Columbia Public School Nurse Assignment
18 Act of 1987 to require that any public school currently receiving school nurse services
19 above 20 hours per week as of October 25, 2016, continue at that existing level of
20 service, or the level recommended by the Department of Health’s risk-based assessment,
21 whichever is greater, for school year 2017-2018.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
24 act may be cited as the “Public School Nurse Assignment Temporary Amendment Act of 2017”.

26 Sec. 2. Section 2 of the District of Columbia Public School Nurse Assignment Act of
27 1987, effective December 10, 1987 (D.C. Law 7-45; D.C. Code § 38-621), is amended as
28 follows:

29 (a) Subsection (c) is repealed.

30 (b) A new subsection (c-1) is added to read as follows:

31 “(c-1) Any school that, on October 25, 2016, received school nursing services pursuant to
32 this section that exceeded the hours per week prescribed by subsection (b) of this section shall
33 continue the level of service existing on that date, or the level recommended by the Department
34 of Health’s risk-based assessment, whichever is greater, for school year 2017-2018.”

35 **Sec. 3. The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Budget Director as the fiscal**
36 **impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975,**
37 **approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).**

38 **Sec. 4. Effective date.**

39 **(a) This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by**
40 **the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review**
41 **as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December**
42 **24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813, D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of**
43 **Columbia Register.**

44 **(b) This act shall expire after 225 days of its having taken effect.**
