10 IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

14 To amend, on an emergency basis, due to congressional review, the Personal Delivery Device Pilot
15 Program Act of 2016 to extend the personal delivery device pilot program through
16 December 31, 2018, and to provide that a registration, including a renewal, issued before
17 December 31, 2017, shall be valid for one year from the date of registration, unless the
18 registration is revoked by the Director of the District Department of Transportation.

20 BE IN ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
21 act may be cited as the “Personal Delivery Device Pilot Program Extension Congressional
22 Review Emergency Amendment Act of 2018”.

23 Sec. 2. The Personal Delivery Device Pilot Program Act of 2016, effective October 8,
24 2016 (D.C. Law 21-160; D.C. Official Code § 50-1551 *et seq.*), is amended as follows:

25 (a) Section 6193 (D.C. Official Code § 50-1552) is amended by striking the phrase
26 “December 31, 2017” and inserting the phrase “December 31, 2018” in its place.

27 (b) Section 6195(b) (D.C. Official Code § 50-1554(b)) is amended by striking the
28 phrase “December 31, 2017, whichever is first.” and inserting the phrase “December 31, 2018,
29 whichever is first; provided, that a registration, including a renewal, issued before December 31,
30 2017, shall be valid for one year from the date of registration, unless the registration is revoked
31 pursuant to subsection (d) of this section.” in its place.

32 Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

33 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Budget Director as the fiscal impact
34 statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved
35 October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

36 Sec. 4. Effective date.

37 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
38 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for no longer than
39 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in section
40 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24th, 1973 (87 Stat. 788:
41 D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a))
