Ward 6, as Bruce Robey Way. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "Bruce Robey Way Designation Act of 2018". Sec. 2. Pursuant to the Street and Alley Closing and Acquisition Procedures Act of 1982, effective March 10, 1983 (D.C. Law 4-201; D.C. Official Code § 9-204.01 et seq.), the Council officially designates the alley in Square 983 that runs east and west between the 600 blocks of 11th and 12th Streets, N.E., and the 1100 blocks of G and F Streets, N.E., in Ward 6, as "Bruce Robey Way" in recognition of Bruce Robey, the founder of the District's "Voice of the Hill" newspaper, and together with his wife, Adele, opened the H Street Playhouse, which was instrumental to the revival of the H Street NE corridor. Mr. Robey was a talented musician, who shared his love of music and the arts with everyone he met. He was generous with his time, his resources, and his friendship. Sec. 3. Transmittal.
