28	act may be cited as the "Baby-Friendly Hospital Initiative Act of 2018".
29	Sec. 2. Definitions.
30	(1) "Perinatal unit" means a maternity and newborn service of the hospital for the
31	provision of care during pregnancy, labor, deliver, and postpartum and neonatal periods with
32	appropriate staff, space, equipment, and supplies.
33	(2) "Baby-Friendly Hospital Initiative" means the program sponsored by the World
34	
	Health Organization (WHO) and the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) that recognizes
35	hospitals that offer an optimal level of care for infant feeding.
36	Sec. 3. Baby-Friendly Hospital Initiative.

37	All general acute care hospitals and special hospitals that have a perinatal unit shall, by
38	October 1, 2025, adopt the "Ten Steps to Successful Breastfeeding," as adopted by Baby-
39	Friendly USA, per the Baby-Friendly Hospital Initiative, or an alternate process adopted by a
40	health care service plan that includes evidenced-based policies and practices and targeted
41	outcomes, or the Model Hospital Policy.

43	The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Budget Director as the fiscal impact
44	statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved
