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21 IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA
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26 To amend the Civil Asset Forfeiture Amendment Act of 2014 to require that currency and sales
27 proceeds received by the Metropolitan Police Department be deposited into the
28 Neighborhood Safety and Engagement Fund and used for violence prevention and
29 intervention initiatives.
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31 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
32 act may be cited as the “Neighborhood Safety and Engagement Fund Violence Prevention and
33 Intervention Initiatives Enhancement Amendment Act of 2018”.

34 Sec. 2. Section 110(a)(2) of the Civil Asset Forfeiture Amendment Act of 2014, effective
35 June 16, 2015 (D.C. Law 20-278; D.C. Official Code § 41-310(a)(3)), is amended as follows:

36 (a) The existing text is designated as subparagraph (A).

37 (b) The newly designated subparagraph (A) is amended by striking the word “Beginning”

38 and inserting the phrase “Except as provided in subparagraph (B), beginning” in its place.

39 (c) A new subparagraph (B) is added to read as follows:

40 “(B) Deposit into the Neighborhood Safety and Engagement Fund, established by
41 section 103 of the Neighborhood Engagement Achieves Results Amendment Act of 2016,
42 effective June 30, 2016 (D.C. Law 21-125; D.C. Official Code § 7-2413), the currency and sale
43 proceeds received by the Metropolitan Police Department to be used for violence prevention and
44 intervention initiatives.”.

45 Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement

46 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal
47 impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975,
48 approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

49 Sec. 4. Effective date.

50 The act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
51 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as
52 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
53 24, 1973, (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
54 Columbia Register.
