14 A BILL

18 IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

24 To exempt parent teacher associations and organizations from registration, licensing, and
25 incorporation fees.

27 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
28 act may be cited as the "Parent Teacher Organization Fee Exemption Act of 2018".

29 Sec. 2. Fee exemption for parent teacher associations or organizations.

30 (a) A parent teacher association or parent teacher organization shall be exempt from
31 registration, licensing, and incorporation fees established pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 29-
32 101.05 and Section 11 of An Act To provide full and fair disclosure of the character of
33 charitable, benevolent, patriotic, or other solicitations in the District of Columbia; and for other
34 purposes, approved July 10, 1957 (71 Stat. 281; D.C. Official Code § 44-1710).

35 (b) For the purposes of this act, "Parent teacher association or parent teacher
36 organization" means a formal organization of parents, teachers, and school staff of an elementary

1 or secondary school that facilitates parental participation in a school and whose activities include
2 fund raising on behalf of the school or its students.

3 Sec. 4. Fiscal impact statement.

4 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal
5 impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975,
6 approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

7 Sec. 5. Effective date.

8 The act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
9 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as
10 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
11 24, 1973, (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
12 Columbia Register.
