26 A BILL

31 IN THE COUNCIL OF DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

35 To amend section 47-2851.04 of the District of Columbia Official Code to reduce the total cost
36 of a basic business license, and all required endorsements, taxes, and fees, for businesses
37 with taxable income of \$100,000 or less.

38 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
40 act may be cited as the "Micro-Business Startup Fee Relief Amendment Act of 2019".

41 Sec. 2. Section 47-2851.04 of the District of Columbia Official Code is amended as
42 follows:

43 (a) A new subsection (c-1) is added to read as follows:

44 "(c-1)(1) By October 1, 2019 the Director shall:

45 "(A) Require new businesses to pay an amount that is 25% of the total of
46 the basic business license fee and any other required endorsements, taxes, and fees; provided that
47 if after the business's first taxable year the business's taxable income exceeds \$100,000, the
48 business shall pay the remaining 75% of the basic business license fee and any other required
49 endorsements, taxes, and fees.

50 "(B) Reduce the total cost of a basic business license renewal and all
51 required endorsements, taxes, and fees by 75% for existing businesses that reported a taxable
52 income of \$100,000 or less in the prior taxable year.

53 "(2) The Mayor may issue rules to implement the provisions of this subsection."

54 Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

55 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal
56 impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975,
57 approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

58 Sec. 4. Effective date.

59 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
60 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of Congressional review as
61 provided in section 602(c)(2) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
62 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(2)), and publication in the District of
63 Columbia Register.
