

Sec. 5. Effective date. A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To officially designate the portions of Tingey Street, S.E., and N Street, S.E., between New Jersey Avenue, S.E., and 2nd Street, S.E., abutting Squares 770, 771 and W-771, in Ward 6, as Tingey Square.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "Tingey Square Designation Act of 2019".

- Sec. 2. Pursuant to sections 401 and 421 of the Street and Alley Closing and Acquisition
- Procedures Act of 1982, effective March 10, 1983 (D.C. Law 4-201; D.C. Official Code §§ 9-
- 204.01, 9-204.03, and 9-204.21), the Council officially designates the portions of Tingey Street,
- S.E., and N Street, S.E., between New Jersey Avenue, S.E., and 2nd Street, S.E., in Ward 6, as
- "Tingey Square".
 - Sec. 3. Transmittal.
- The Council shall transmit a copy of this act, upon its effective date, to the Mayor, the
 - District Department of Transportation, and the Office of the Surveyor.
 - Sec. 4. Fiscal impact statement.
 - The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975,
- approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as provided in section 603(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of Columbia Register.
