A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To amend, on a temporary basis, the District of Columbia Election Code of 1955 to allow the Board of Elections to receive absentee ballots mailed on or before Election Day up to seven days after the election, to move the primary election date in presidential election years to the first Tuesday in June, and to allow the Board of Elections to conduct early voting two days earlier than currently provided.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this

act may be cited as the “Primary Date Alteration Temporary Amendment Act of 2019”.

Sec. 2. The District of Columbia Election Code of 1955, approved August 12, 1955 (69)

Stat. 699; D.C. Official Code § 1-1001.01 *et seq.*), is amended as follows:

(a) Section 5 (D.C. Official Code § 1-1001.05) is amended as follows:

25 (2) Subsection (b)(1) is amended by striking the phrase "3rd Tuesday" and
26 inserting the phrase "1st Tuesday" in its place.

27 (b) Section 9(b-1)(2) (D.C. Official Code § 1-1001.09(b-1)(2)) is amended by striking the
28 number “10” and inserting the number “12” in its place.

29 (c) Section 10(a) (D.C. Official Code § 1-1001.10(a)) is amended as follows:

30 (1) Paragraph (1) is amended by striking the phrase “3rd Tuesday” and inserting
31 the phrase “1st Tuesday” in its place.

32 (2) Paragraph (3) is amended as follows:

33 (A) Subparagraph (A) is amended by striking the phrase “3rd Tuesday in
34 June of each even-numbered year” and inserting the phrase “1st Tuesday in June in a presidential
35 election year and on the 3rd Tuesday in June of each even-numbered non-presidential election
36 year” in its place.

37 (B) Subparagraph (B) is amended by striking the phrase “3rd Tuesday in
38 June of each even-numbered year” and inserting the phrase “1st Tuesday in June in a presidential
39 election year and on the 3rd Tuesday in June of each even-numbered non-presidential election
40 year” in its place.

41 Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

42 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Budget Director as the fiscal impact
43 statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved
44 October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

46 (a) This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by
47 the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review
48 as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
