18	(a) Subsection (a) is amended by striking the phrase "Department to" and inserting the
19	phrase "District to" in its place.
20	(b) Subsection (b) is amended by striking the phrase "the Office" and inserting the phrase
21	"the Department of General Services and the Office" in its place.
22	(c) Subsection (d)(1) is amended by striking the word "Department" and inserting the
23	word "District" in its place.
24	(d) A new subsection (d-1) is added to read as follows:
25	"(d-1) The Department may waive the requirements in subsection (d)(2) and (3) of this
26	section when the lessee does not grow produce in the site soil of the leased property but instead

27	uses, for example, raised beds, greenhouses, or hydroponic towers, provided that the lease
28	agreement includes a provision stating that the lessee will not plant in or use the site soil.".

34	(a) This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by
35	the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as
36	provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24,
37	1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
38	Columbia Register.
39	(b) This act shall expire after 225 days of its having taken effect.
