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26 A BILL
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31 IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA
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36 To amend the Vending Regulation Act of 2009 to exempt minors from a mandatory business
37 license when operating a small-scale business.

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2 BE IT ENACTED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
3 act may be cited as the “Lemonade Stand Amendment Act of 2019”.

4 Sec. 2. The Vending Regulation Act of 2009, effective October 22, 2009, (D.C. Law 18-
5 71; D.C. Official Code § 37-131.01 *et seq.*), is amended as follows:

6 (a) Section 2 (D.C. Official Code § 37-131.01) is amended by adding a new paragraph
7 (2A) to read as follows:

8 “(2A) “Small-scale business” means a business entity selling no more than 10
9 types of items on a sporadic basis.”.

10 (b) Section 3 (D.C. Official Code § 37-131.02) is amended as follows:

11 (1) Subsection (a) is amended by the phrase “subsection (b)” and inserting the
12 phrase “subsection (b) and (b-1)” in its place.

13 (2) A new subsection (b-1) is added to read as follows

14 “(b-1) A minor who is running a small-scale business may operate without a basic
15 business license or vending site permit; provided, that:

16 “(1) The small-scale business is in operation no more than 100 days per calendar
17 year; and

18 “(2) The small-scale business is located a reasonable distance from a licensed
19 commercial entity, as determined in rules issued by the Department of Consumer and Regulatory
20 Affairs.”.

21 Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement

22 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal
23 impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975,
24 approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

1 Sec. 4. Effective date.

2 The act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
3 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as
4 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
5 24, 1973, (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
6 Columbia Register.
