5 IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

10 To provide, on a temporary basis, that expenditures on school-administered theatrical and music
11 performances, including stipends for non- District of Columbia Public Schools
12 employees, shall be allowable expenditures from a school's Student Activity Fund.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
15 act may be cited as the "Student Activity Fund Theatrical and Music Performance Expenditures
16 Act of 2010".

18 (a) Expenditures on school-administered theatrical and music performances, including
19 stipends for non-District of Columbia Public Schools (“DCPS”) employees, but excluding
20 stipends for DCPS employees, shall be an allowable expenditure from a DCPS school’s Student
21 Activity Fund.

22 (b) For the purposes of this act, the term “theatrical and music performances” means the
23 planning, rehearsal, or presentation of a musical, staged play, choral production, orchestral or
24 band concert, variety show, improvised or sketch comedy performance, or other live

33 (a) This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by
34 the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as
35 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24,
36 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
37 Columbia Register.

38 (b) This act shall expire after 225 days of its having taken effect.
