#### Conclusion

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2020 through fiscal year 2023 budget and financial plan to implement the bill.

### **Background**

The bill expands the Deputy Mayor for Planning and Economic Development's (DMPED) grantmaking authority to include issuing grants to organizations that operate in the District's Wards 5, 7, or 8 and support increasing economic development in underserved areas.

## Financial Plan Impact

Funds are sufficient in the fiscal year 2020 through fiscal year 2023 budget and financial plan to implement the bill. The bill authorizes DMPED to issue grants to economic development organizations that operate in Wards 5, 7, or 8. The fiscal year 2020 budget includes \$2 million for DMPED to issue these grants, but the funding is currently part of the Paygo capital budget¹ and needs to be reprogrammed to the operating budget. There are no costs associated with giving DMPED this
