Dear Chairman Mendelson:

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51(b), the Department of General Services (the "Department") hereby submits to the Council of the District of Columbia for its review and approval the attached proposed emergency legislation, "Contract No. DCAM-19-CS-RFQ-0001S and Modification No. 1 with Thiha, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2020," and corresponding emergency declaration to authorize payment for services received and to be received under Basic Ordering Agreement ("BOA") DCAM-19-CS-RFQ-0001S for Small General Construction Projects (the "Contract") and proposed Modification No. 1 (the "Modification") between the Department and Thiha, Inc. (the "Contractor"). The Contract is an indefinite delivery and indefinite quantity ("ID/IQ") type and any work thereunder is awarded through task orders issued on a competitive basis.

The underlying Contract, with a guaranteed minimum value of \$50.00 and a not-to-exceed ("NTE") amount of \$990,000.00, was executed on May 28, 2019. Thus, the Contract was not submitted to Council for approval, as the NTE value was less than \$1 million.

The proposed Modification would increase the Contract's NTE amount to \$3,500,000.00, and authorize the Contractor to provide small general construction services on a task order basis. As


the proposed NTE amount exceeds \$1 million, the Department seeks Council's approval of the proposed Modification.

The Agency Fiscal Officer has certified that funding remains available for the Contract's \$50.00 guaranteed minimum value for FY 2020 and funds supporting individual task orders issued against the NTE amount will be certified at the time of issuance, subject to the availability of appropriated funds.

In addition to the Contract and proposed Modification, attached are: (i) a Council Contract Summary; (ii) a Clean Hands Certificate for the Contractor; (iii) a fiscal certification; (iv) legal sufficiency reviews and certifications; (v) a proposed emergency declaration; and (vi) proposed legislation.

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve, on an emergency basis, Contract No. DCAM-19-CS-RFQ-0001S and Modification No. 1 between the Department of General Services and Thiha, Inc., increasing the Contract's aggregate not-to-exceed ("NTE") amount to \$3.5 million and authorizing payment to Thiha, Inc. for goods and services received and to be received under the contract and modification.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,

That this act may be cited as the "Contract No. DCAM-19-CS-RFQ-0001S and Modification No. 1 with Thiha, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2020".

Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 451 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51), the Council approves Contract No. DCAM-19-CS-RFQ-0001S and Modification No. 01 between the Department of General Services and Thiha, Inc. for small general construction projects, increasing the aggregate not-to-exceed ("NTE") amount of the Contract to \$3.5 million, and authorizing payment to Thiha, Inc. for goods and services received and to be received under this contract and modification.

Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

1 The Council adopts the fiscal statement of the Chief Financial Officer as the fiscal
2 impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of

Explanation of difference from base period (if Applicable):

The proposed, increased NTE amount of \$3,500,000 for the base period ("Base Period) and four (4) one-year option period ("Option Years), is \$2,510,000 more than the initial NTE amount of \$990,000 for the base period ("Base Period) and four (4) one-year option periods ("Option Years) is based on the current anticipated needs for small general construction services at various District owned or operated public schools, parks and recreation centers, and other municipal facilities.

- (C) **The goods or services to be provided, the methods of delivering goods or services, and any significant program changes reflected in the proposed contract:**

On May 28, 2019, the underlying Contract for Small General Construction (DCAM-19-CS-RFQ-0001S) (the "Contract") between the Department of General Services ("the Department" or DGS") and Thiha, Inc. (the "Contractor") was executed with a guaranteed minimum amount of \$50 and NTE amount of \$990,000 for Contract's Base Period and four (4) one-year option period ("Option Years). The Contract which is a basic ordering agreement ("BOA") contract, authorizes the Contractor to provide small general construction services, as awarded via Task Order Agreements at lump sum prices, at various DGS facilities within DGS' real estate portfolio (the "Project"). The Project locations include schools, parks, recreation facilities, municipal buildings, fire and police stations, short-term family housing, tenant fit-out type work, small park/playground work, pools, other public locations, etc. The Contractor is responsible for providing all types of small general construction services. That action was not submitted to Council for approval, as the NTE amount was less than \$1,000,000.

Proposed Modification No. 1, like the underlying Contract does not authorize any specific work or constitute a guarantee that any work will be assigned to the Contractor. All work has been/will be awarded and released through individual Project task order agreements, as set forth in the

Contract. As the aggregate NTE amount of proposed Modification No. 1 exceeds \$1 million, Council approval is required.

(D) The selection process, number of offerors, the evaluation criteria, and the evaluation results, experience, past performance of the team, key personnel, project management plan, and capacity components:

On February 8, 2019, the Department issued a Request for Qualification ("RFQ") to engage multiple contractors to perform Small General Construction Projects at District owned properties within the DGS construction portfolio and maintenance facility locations. The RFQ was posted on the Department's website.

This solicitation was identified for the Department's SBE Set-Aside Program "Pre-qualification of Small General Contractors, Trade Subcontractors and Related Construction Service Providers".

A project information meeting was held on February 12, 2019 at the Department's Adams Morgan Conference Room located at 1250 U Street NW, Washington DC 20009, 3rd Floor.

There were five (5) Addenda issued:

- Addendum No. 1, issued on February 26, 2019, extended the statement of qualifications ("SOQ") submission date to March 8, 2019, transmitted the Information Meeting Sign-In Sheet, the Bidder-Offeror Certification Form, and incorporated the Tax Affidavit and Past Performance Evaluation into the RFQ.
- Addendum No. 2, issued on March 6, 2019, extended the SOQ submission date to March 15, 2019.
- Addendum No. 3, issued on March 7, 2019, incorporated the Request for Information (RFI)/ Questions and Answers, and Revised the RFQ Executive Summary, replaced the term "General Contractors" with "Prime Contractor", and clarified terms within the RFQ.
- Addendum No. 4, issued on March 13, 2019, extended the SOQ submission date to March 19, 2019.
- Addendum No. 5, issued on March 15, 2019, provided the Basic Ordering Agreement, provided additional RFIs and Award Signature page, and clarified terms of the Project Management Plan.

Sixty (60) firms (collectively, the "Bidders" and each individually, a "Bidder") submitted SOQs in a timely manner on March 19, 2019, the SOQs Due Date.

Due to the number of SOQs received, the evaluation process has been broken into groups (Group 1, Group 2, Group 3, and Group 4). Each group of proposals were disbursed to the Technical Evaluation Panel (TEP) members with Evaluation score sheets specifically for each group. Four technical categories were comprised into a 100 point scale as follows: (i) Past

Performance, Experience & References worth, 25 Points; (ii) Key Personnel, worth 25 points; (iii) Project Management Plan, worth 25 Points; and (iv) Capacity, worth 25 points.

The groups were prioritized by the needs of the District. TEP Members met to discuss their respective technical scores for each Offeror within each Group. TEP Members completed individual evaluations of proposals. TEP members discussed details of each proposals, in addition to evaluation factors and sub-factors as consensus scores were developed. The TEP Panel met often for group Consensus meetings. Offerors that scored 50 points or higher from each group were selected as qualified contractors for award. The Contracting Officer reviewed TEP's technical scoring and the statement of qualifications (SOQs) submitted, and determined that fifty-seven (57) Contractors including Thiha, Inc., out of sixty (60) are qualified, responsive and responsible and awarded the BOAs. The Award Memorandum provides a greater amount of detail on the selection process.

- (E) A description of any bid protest related to the award of the contract, including whether the protest was resolved through litigation, withdrawal of the protest by the protestor, or voluntary corrective action by the District. Include the identity of the protestor, the grounds alleged in the protest, and any deficiencies identified by the District as a result of the protest:**

The award of the Contract was not protested.

- (F) The background and qualifications of the proposed contractor, including its organization, financial stability, personnel, and performance on past or current government or private sector contracts with requirements similar to those of the proposed contract:**

Thiha, Inc. is a Certified Small Business Enterprise (SBE) based in Washington DC. The Contractor was founded in June 20, 2003 with specialization in project management services, construction, construction management, and architect/engineer services. Thiha, Inc., is dedicated in the execution of requirements as a Certified Business Enterprise in the District of Columbia. The Contractor has a history of working with several agencies with the District of Columbia Government. Thiha, Inc., has been awarded and satisfactory performed three (3) small general construction projects for the District under Contract No. DCAM-19-CS-RFQ-0001S. The Contractor has been determined responsible in accordance with Chapter 27 DCMR 1406.1.

- (G) The period of performance associated with the proposed change, including date as of which the proposed change is to be made effective:**

The period of performance associated with Modification No. 1 is the Base Period, May 28, 2019 through May 27, 2020. Proposed Modification No. 1 will become effective upon approval by the Council and execution by the Department.

- (H) The value of any work or services performed pursuant to a proposed change for which the Council has not provided approval, disaggregated by each proposed change if more than one proposed change has been aggregated for Council review:**

Under Contract No. DCAM-19-CS-RFQ-0001S, with a guaranteed minimum value of \$50 and a maximum NTE amount of \$990,000, Thiha Inc., has been awarded the following four (4) task orders:

1. Task Order No. 1 (\$494,509.67) - Lockdown Door Hardware Replacement.
2. Task Order No. 2 (\$34,000.00) - Small General Construction Services for District of Columbia Schools.
3. Task Order No. 3 (\$230,260.00) - Stanton Elementary School Emergency HVAC Repairs Modification.
4. Task Order No. 4 (\$197,286.00) - One Judiciary Square IT Closets HVAC Upgrade.

(I) The aggregate dollar value of the proposed changes as compared with the amount of the contract as awarded:

The Contract, as awarded, contemplated a Base Period and four (4) one-year option periods ("Option Years) valued at a maximum NTE amount of \$990,000, with a guaranteed minimum amount of \$50, and Thiha, Inc. (the "Contractor") has already been issued four (4) task orders totaling an aggregate amount of \$956,055.67. The Department now seeks Council's approval for proposed Modification No. 1 to increase the maximum NTE amount from \$990,000 to \$3,500,000. Since the proposed change exceeds \$1 million, Council approval is required.

(J) The date on which the contracting officer was notified of the proposed change:

October 11, 2019.

(K) The reason why the proposed change was sent to Council for approval after it is intended to take effect:

The proposed change will exceed \$1 million, so therefore, Council approval is required.

(L) The reason for the proposed change:

Thiha, Inc. (the "Contractor") has already been issued four (4) task orders totaling an aggregate amount of \$956,055.67 under Contract No. DCAM-19-CS-RFQ-0001S. The Department now seeks Council's approval for proposed Modification No. 1 to increase the maximum NTE amount from \$990,000 to \$3,500,000 and ensure that adequate funding is available for Contractor to continue providing necessary small general construction services through individual competitively awarded task orders. Since the proposed change exceeds \$1 million, Council approval is required.

(M) The legal, regulatory, or contractual authority for the proposed change:

The Department wishes to increase the NTE value from \$990,000 to \$3,500,000 through Modification No. 1, and ensure that adequate funding is available for the Contractor to continue providing necessary small general construction services. The proposed Modification No. 1 would increase the total contract value in an aggregate amount in excess of \$1 million, thus the proposed contract action is subject to the requirements of the District of Columbia Home Rule

Act, codified at D.C. official Code §1-204.51(b). Thus, Council review and approval of the proposed contract action is required under the District of Columbia Home Rule Act. The proposed Modification would be authorized by Council's enactment of Contract No. DCAM-19-CS-RFQ-0001S and Modification No. 1 with Thiha, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2020.

- (N) **A summary of the subcontracting plan required under section 2346 of the Small, Local, and Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Development and Assistance Act of 2005, as amended, D.C. Official Code § 2-218.01 *et seq.* ("Act"), including a certification that the subcontracting plan meets the minimum requirements of the Act and the dollar volume of the portion of the contract to be subcontracted, expressed both in total dollars and as a percentage of the total contract amount:**

Pursuant to the Contract, competitive task orders will be issued for projects on an as needed basis. The Contractor is a certified business enterprise in accordance with the Act (Certification No. LS DR90965042022). As appropriate, subcontracting plans will be submitted for review and approval for each task order with a value of \$250,000 or more.

- (O) **Performance standards and the expected outcome of the proposed contract:**

In general, the Contractor will continue to provide small general construction services for the Project. The Contractor will be required to meet or exceed performance standards in accordance with the Contract's scope of work. DGS staff will continue to monitor the Contractor's performance to ensure consistency with the Contract's terms and conditions, and, more specifically, the established pricing and completion dates included in individual task orders executed.

- (P) **The amount and date of any expenditure of funds by the District pursuant to the contract prior to its submission to the Council for approval:**

Contract No. DCAM-19-CS-RFQ-0001S was executed on May 28, 2019 in the NTE amount of \$990,000, with a guaranteed minimum amount of \$50. Thiha, Inc. (the "Contractor") has been issued four (4) task orders with total aggregate amount of \$956,055.67 as follows:

1. Task Order No. 1 (\$494,509.67): Issued in the amount of \$434,829.00 for Lockdown Door Hardware Replacement and increased to \$494,509.67 by \$59,680.67 through a modification to task order.
2. Task Order No. 2 (\$34,000.00): Issued in the amount of \$34,000.00 for Small General Construction Services for District of Columbia Schools.
3. Task Order No. 3 (\$230,260.00): Issued with a NTE amount of \$230,260.00 for Stanton Elementary School Emergency HVAC Repairs Modification.
4. Task Order No. 4 (\$197,286.00): Issued with a NTE amount of \$197,286.00 for One Judiciary Square IT Closets HVAC Upgrade.

- (Q) **A certification that the proposed contract is within the appropriated budget authority for the agency for the fiscal year and is consistent with the financial plan and budget adopted in accordance with D.C. Official Code §§ 47-392.01 and 47-392.02:**

The Agency Fiscal Officer has certified that the proposed Modification No. 1 is within the Department's appropriated budget authority for the fiscal year and is consistent with the financial plan and budget adopted in accordance with D.C. Official Code §§ 47-392.01 and 47-392.02. The relevant certification accompanies this Council Package.

- (R) A certification that the contract is legally sufficient, including whether the proposed contractor has any pending legal claims against the District:**

The proposed Modification No. 1 to Contract No. DCAM-19-CS-RFQ-0001S has been deemed legally sufficient by DGS' General Counsel, and the Contractor appears to have no pending legal claims against the District.

- (S) A certification that Citywide Clean Hands database indicates that the proposed contractor is current with its District taxes. If the Citywide Clean Hands Database indicates that the proposed contractor is not current with its District taxes, either: (1) a certification that the contractor has worked out and is current with a payment schedule approved by the District; or (2) a certification that the contractor will be current with its District taxes after the District recovers any outstanding debt as provided under D.C. The Citywide Clean Hands database indicates that the Contractor is current with its District taxes. The relevant Clean Hands Certificate accompanies this Council Package.

The Contractor has certified that it is current with its federal taxes.

- (U) The status of the proposed contractor as a certified local, small, or disadvantaged business enterprise as defined in the Small, Local, and Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Development and Assistance Act of 2005, as amended; D.C. Official Code § 2-218.01 *et seq.*:**

According to the DSLBD's website, the Contractor is a Certified Local, Small, or Disadvantaged Business Enterprise. The Contractor's Certification Number is LSDR90965042022, with an expiration date of April 8, 2022.

- (V) Other aspects of the proposed contract that the Contracting Officer considers significant:**

- (W) A statement indicating whether the proposed contractor is currently debarred from providing services or goods to the District or federal government, the dates of the debarment, and the reasons for debarment:**

The Contractor is not debarred from providing services to the Government of the District of Columbia or the Federal Government according to the Office of Contracts and Procurement's Excluded Parties List and the Federal Government's Excluded Parties List.

- (X) Any determination and findings issues relating to the contract's formation, including any determination and findings made under D.C. Official Code § 2-352.05 (privatization contracts):**

On January 6, 2020, the Department issued a Determination and Findings with respect to proposed Modification No. 1 for the \$2,510,000 increase in the aggregate NTE amount in which DGS' Contracting Officer concluded that the increase is fair and reasonable and in the best interest of the District in order to meet the required services.
