

A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To amend the District of Columbia Revenue Act of 1937 to require the Mayor to design and issue motor vehicle identification tags that celebrate the Washington Mystics 2019 Women's National Basketball Championship.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,

That this act may be cited as the "Washington Mystics Motor Vehicle Identification Tags Amendment Act of 2020".

44 Sec. 2. Title IV of the District of Columbia Revenue Act of 1937, approved August 17,
45 1937 (50 Stat. 679; D.C. Official Code § 50-1501.01 *et seq.*), is amended by adding a new
46 section 2i to read as follows:

47 “Sec. 2i. Issuance of Washington Mystics motor vehicle identification tags.

48 “(a) The Mayor shall design and make available for issue one or more Washington
49 Mystics motor vehicle identification tags to demonstrate support for the Washington Mystics
50 basketball team and celebrate the Washington Mystics 2019 Women’s National Basketball
51 Association Championship.

52 “(b)(1) A resident ordering a Washington Mystics tag shall pay a one-time application fee
53 and an annual display fee. The application fee shall be \$25, and the display fee shall be \$20, or
54 such other amount as may be established by the Mayor by rule.

55 “(2) The application fee and annual display shall be deposited into the General
56 Fund for the District of Columbia.”.

57 Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

58 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal
59 impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975,
60 approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

61 Sec. 4. Effective date.

62 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor or in the event of veto by the
63 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto, a 30-day period of congressional review as
64 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
65 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1), and publication in the District of
66 Columbia Register.
