






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23 IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA
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29 To amend the District of Columbia Revenue Act of 1937 to require the Mayor to issue a motor
30 vehicle identification tag with the legend "END GUN VIOLENCE".

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32 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,

33 That this act may be cited as the "End Gun Violence Motor Vehicle Identification Tags
34 Amendment Act of 2020".

35 Sec. 2. Title IV of the District of Columbia Revenue Act of 1937, approved August 17,
36 1937 (50 Stat. 679; D.C. Official Code § 50-1501.01 *et seq.*), is amended by adding a new
37 section 2i to read as follows:

38 "Sec. 2i. Issuance of END GUN VIOLENCE motor vehicle identification tags.

37 “(b)(1) A resident ordering an END GUN VIOLENCE tag shall pay a one-time
38 application fee and an annual display fee. The application fee shall be \$25, and the display fee
39 shall be \$20, or such other amount as may be established by the Mayor by rule.

40 “(2) The application fee and annual display shall be deposited into the Crime
41 Victims Assistance Fund.”.

42 Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

43 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal
44 impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975,
45 approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

46 Sec. 4. Effective date.

47 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor or in the event of veto by the
48 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto, a 30-day period of congressional review as
49 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
50 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1), and publication in the District of
51 Columbia Register.
