18	(a) Within 28 days after the effective date of this act, the District Department of			
19	Transportation ("DDOT") shall publish a report identifying modifications to at least 20 miles of			
20	streets in the District, including streets in all eight wards, that will allow, in the roadway, uses			
21	other than for motorized vehicles, such as for bicycles. The streets identified pursuant to this			
22	subsection shall, to the greatest extent possible, be connected to each other, creating a network of			
23	lanes or safe traveling spaces.			
24	(b) The modifications identified pursuant to subsection (a) of this section shall be one of,			
25	or a combination of, the following:			
26	(1) Closure of a street to through traffic;			
27	(2) Creation of a protected bicycle lane; or			

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28	(3) Reduction of travel lanes to expand public space.		
29	(c)(1) By September 1, 2020, DDOT shall implement at least 20 miles of the		
30	modifications identified in the report required by paragraph (1) of this subsection, except no		
31	modifications shall be implemented in Ward 8.		
32	(2) By October 15, 2020, DDOT shall amend the report required by paragraph (1)		
33	of this subsection, except no modifications shall be implemented in Ward 8. to include at least 5		
34	additional miles of modifications.		
35	(3) By November 1, 2020, DDOT shall have implemented at least another 5 miles		
36	of modifications identified in the report required by paragraph (1) of this subsection, except no		
37	modifications shall be implemented in Ward 8.		
38	(d) Modifications made in accordance with the report described in (a)(1) of this		
39	subsection shall remain in place until at least 270 days following the expiration of a public health		
40	emergency declared pursuant to section 5a of the District of Columbia Public Emergency Act of		
41	1980, effective October 17, 2002 (D.C. Law 14-194; D.C. Official Code § 7-2304.01), or at such		
42	time as the Mayor declares the District to be in phase 4 of reopening as described in the ReOpen		
43	DC Advisory Group Recommendations to the Mayor, whichever is later in time.

Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of 52 Columbia Register.
