SUBJECT: FY 2020 Reprogramming Request: \$1,000,000.00 in Capital Funds from the Paid Family Leave IT Application Project to the DGS 2021 Inauguration Reviewing Stands Project

Dear Chairman Mendelson:

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 47-363(a), I am transmitting the enclosed request to reprogram \$1,000,000.00 of Fiscal Year 2020 capital funds from the Paid Family Leave IT Application project to the Department of General Services 2021 Inauguration Reviewing Stands Project. These funds will be used for the planning, design and pre-construction of the reviewing stands to be used during the Presidential inauguration in January 2021.

This emergency, the "Inauguration Reviewing Stands Project Reprogramming Emergency Approval Act of 2020" and accompanying emergency declaration resolution are necessary in order for DGS to complete the construction of the reviewing stands in time for the 2021 inauguration. These funds will support planning, design and pre-construction activities that must be completed in the remaining months of FY 2020 in order to meet the construction deadline. Federal funding for the remainder of the project will be available in FY 2021.

I urge the Council to take prompt and favorable action on this measure.
