A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

---

To symbolically designate First Street, N.W., between Bryant Street, N.W. and Michigan Avenue, N.W., in Ward 5 as Alpha Phi Alpha Way.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “Mid-Atlantic Association of Alpha Phi Alpha Chapters (MAAC) Alpha Phi Alpha Way Designation Act of 2020”.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to sections 401, 403a, and 423 of the Street and Alley Closing Acquisition Procedures Act of 1982, effective March 10, 1983 (D.C. Law 4-201; D.C. Official Code § 9-204.01, 9-204.03a, and 9-204.23), the Council symbolically designates the First Street, N.W., between Bryant Street, N.W., and Michigan Avenue, N.W., in Ward 5, as “Alpha Phi Alpha Way”.

Sec. 4. Fiscal impact statement.

1           The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal  
2 impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975,  
3 approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

4           Sec. 5. Effective date.

5           This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the  
6 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as  
7 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act approved December  
8 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of  
9 Columbia Register.
