IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To amend the District of Columbia Comprehensive Plan Act of 1984 to establish and update a broad range of goals, policies, and actions to guide public decisions by both District and federal agencies.

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA that this
- act may be cited as the "Comprehensive Plan Amendment Act of 2020."
- Sec. 2. The District of Columbia Comprehensive Plan Act of 1984, effective April 10,
- 1984 (D.C. Law 5-76; D.C. Official Code § 1-306.01 et seq.), is amended as follows:
- Chapters 1 and 3 through 25 of Section 3 (10-A DCMR §§ 100.1 et seq. and (a)
 - 300.1 through 2500.1 et seq.) are repealed and replaced by the District Elements of the
- Comprehensive Plan for the National Capital submitted by the Mayor to the Council on XX,
- 2020. The text and graphics of the submittal are incorporated into and deemed a part of this act
 - as if contained herein.
 - Sec. 3. Publication requirement exemption
- Notwithstanding section 9 [effective date], subsection 308(b) of the District of Columbia
- Administrative Procedure Act, effective March 6, 1979 (D.C. Law 2-153; D.C. Official Code 8
- 2-558(b)), and section 204 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act of 1975,

- October 8, 1975 (D.C. Law 1-19; D.C. Official Code § 2-602), the text, maps, and graphics of
- 2 the District elements of the Comprehensive Plan for the National Capital, as amended by this act,
- 3 need not be published in the District of Columbia Register to become effective.
- 4 Sec. 4. Applicability.
- No District Element of the Comprehensive Plan for the National Capital shall apply until
- 6 it has been reviewed by the National Capital Planning Commission as provided in section 2(a) of
- 7 the National Capital Planning Act of 1952, approved June 6, 1924 (43 Stat. 463; D.C. Official
- 8 Code § 2-1002(a)), and section 423 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved 24,
- 9 1973 (87 Stat. 792; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.23).
- Sec. 5. Fiscal impact statement.
- The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal
- impact statement required by section 602(c)(3) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act,
- 13 approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(3)).
- Sec. 6. Effective date.
- This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
- Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of Congressional review as
- provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
- 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
- 19 Columbia Register.
