8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That
9	this act may be cited as the "New Convention Center Hotel Omnibus Financing and
10	Development Temporary Amendment Act of 2021".
11	Sec. 2. Section 105 of the New Convention Center Hotel Omnibus Financing and
12	Development Act of 2006, effective September 19, 2006 (D.C. Law 16-163; D.C. Official Code
13	§ 10-1221.05), is amended by adding a new subsection (d) to read as follows:
14	""(d)(1) The Council approves and authorizes the issuance of a replacement bond to the
15	Authority as security for any refunding bonds issued by the Authority for purposes of refunding
16	a series of bonds of the Authority that are secured by a bond issued pursuant to this act.
17	"(2) The issuance of the replacement bond shall comply with the requirements of
18	this act; except, that the principal amount of any replacement bond issued pursuant to this
19	subsection shall be in an amount equal to the principal amount of the refunding bonds issued by
20	the Authority.".

23	fiscal impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of
24	1975, approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

26	(a) This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by
27	the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review
28	as provided in section 602(c)(1)of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
29	24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
30	Columbia Register.
31	(b) This act shall expire after 225 days of its having taken effect.
