22	pole or taking it out of service shall:
23	(1) Remove the pole and associated ground stakes from the public space within 90
24	days;
25	(2) Notify any entity that has assets co-located on the pole, of the removal date,
26	such notifications to be sent no later than 5 business days after replacing the pole or taking it out
27	of service; and
28	(3) Repair any damaged sidewalk or pavement around the place where the pole
29	was removed within 30 days of the removal.
30	(b) For the purposes of this section, the term "Utility company" shall have the same
