
Council action is necessary to approve the contract in the not-to-exceed amount of to \$1,841,224.00 for the period from January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021.

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A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve, on an emergency basis, Modification Nos. 2, 3, 4, and 5 to Contract No. CW77091 with Quality Plan Administrators, Inc. to provide to provide vision care services for eligible District employees, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the modification.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,

That this act may be cited as the “Modifications to Contract No. CW77091 with Quality Plan Administrators, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2021”.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 451 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51), and notwithstanding the requirements of section 202 of the Procurement Practices Reform Act of 2010, effective April 8, 2011 (D.C. Law 18-371; D.C. Official Code § 2-352.02), the Council approves Modification Nos. 2, 3, 4, and 5 to Contract No. CW77091 with Quality Plan Administrators, Inc., to provide vision care services for eligible District employees, and authorizes payment in the amount not-to-exceed \$1,841,224.00 for the goods and services received and to be received under the modifications.

Sec. 3. The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement provided by the Chief Financial Officer as the fiscal impact statement required by section 4a of the General

Solicitation No. Doc457528 was issued as a request for proposal on July 30, 2019. The District received two proposals that were evaluated in accordance with the evaluation criteria set forth in the solicitation. QPA submitted the highest ranked proposal per the evaluation criteria in the solicitation and was awarded the contract.

QPA has provided vision care services for the eligible employees of District of Columbia Government for over 8 years

Modification 2 - option period two, was partially awarded to the contractor with a NTE amount of \$995,000 on December 28, 2020.

Modification 3 - partially exercised option period two for an additional thirty days through April 30, 2021.

Modification 4 - partially exercised option period two for an additional 60 days.

Upon approval of this tipping action the period of performance of the option period for Modification 5 will be extended through December 31, 2021 with a NTE amount of \$1,841,224.




