A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To amend the District of Columbia Election Code of 1955 to clarify voting by mobile application in elections is permitted.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “Voter Mobile App Amendment Act of 2021”.

Sec. 2. The District of Columbia Election Code of 1955, approved August 12, 1955 (69 Stat. 699; D.C. Official Code § 1-1001.01 *et. seq.*), is amended as follows:

(a) Section 2(27) (D.C. Official Code § 1-1001.02(27)) is amended as follows:

(1) Subparagraph(B) is amended by striking the phrase, “; and” and inserting a semicolon in its place.

(2) Subparagraph (C) is amended by striking the phrase, “ballot.” and inserting the phrase, “ballot; and” in its place.

(3) A new subparagraph (D) is added to read as follows

”(D) Cast a vote on a ballot.”.

Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D. C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

Sec. 4. Effective date.

31 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
32 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as
33 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
34 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the district of
35 Columbia Register.
