29	complaints related to incarcerated individuals' health, safety, welfare, and rights;
30	(c) The Office of the Ombudsman and Incarcerated Individual Affairs shall provide
31	information to incarcerated individuals and families regarding self-advocacy;
32	(d) The Office of the Ombudsman and Incarcerated Individual Affairs shall identify
33	system issues;

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34	(e) The Office of the Ombudsman and Incarcerated Individual Affairs shall monitor and
35	ensure compliance of the DC Central Detention Facility with relevant statutes, rules, and policies

38	(f) Correspondence and communication with the Office of the Ombudsman and

45	This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
46	Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as

48	24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the district of
49	Columbia Register.
