20	Sec. 2. Section 4(a-1) of the District of Columbia Workers' Compensation Act of 1979,
21	effective July 1, 1980 (D.C. Law 3-77; D.C. Official Code § 32-1503(a-1)), is amended to read
22	as follows:
23	"(a-1)(1) Notwithstanding any other law, the payment or award of compensation under
24	the workers' compensation law of any other state to an employee or his dependent shall not bar a
25	claim for compensation under this act for the same injury or death; provided, that any such award
26	of compensation under this act shall be reduced by the amount of compensation received or
27	awarded under the workers' compensation law of any other state.
28	"(2) This subsection shall apply to all claims under this act that are pending as of
29	the effective date of the Parity in Workers' Compensation Recovery Emergency Amendment Act

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30	of 2022, as introduced on June XX, 2022 (Bill 24-XXX), and all claims under this act filed after
31	the effective date of the Parity in Workers' Compensation Recovery Emergency Amendment Act
32	of 2022, as introduced on June XX, 2022 (Bill 24-XXX).".

38	(a) This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by
39	the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review
40	as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
41	24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
42	Columbia Register.
