15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
16	act may be cited as the "Public Service Commission Member Qualifications Temporary
17	Amendment Act of 2022".
18	Sec. 2. Paragraph 97(a) of Section 8 of An Act Making appropriations to provide for the
19	expenses of the government of the District of Columbia for the fiscal year ending June thirtieth,
20	nineteen hundred and fourteen and for other purposes, approved March 4, 1913 (37 Stat. 995;
21	D.C. Official Code § 34-801), is amended by striking the phrase "1978." and inserting the phrase
22	"1978. The first member individual nominated after July 1, 2022, shall have substantive
23	expertise in electric grid modernization, renewable energy integration or technology, and, where
24	possible, issues impacting the environment; provided, that this requirement shall not apply to the
25	renomination of a member serving on the Commission as of July 1, 2022." in its place.
26	Sec. 3. The Public Service Commission Member Qualifications Temporary Amendment
27	Act of 2021, effective February 18, 2022 (D.C. Law 24-64; 68 DCR 13507), is repealed.

31	(a) This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by
32	the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as
33	provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24,
34	1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
35	Columbia Register.
36	(b) This act shall expire after 225 days of its having taken effect.
