17 IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

20 To amend the Advisory Neighborhood Commissions Act of 1975 to establish notice
21 requirements for the Department of Public Works before the removal of public litter
22 containers.

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
25 act may be cited as the "Requirement to Provide Notice of Intent to Remove Public Litter
26 Containers Amendment Act of 2022".

27 Sec. 2. Section 13(c) of the Advisory Neighborhood Commissions Act of 1975, effective
28 March 26, 1976 (D.C. Law 1-58; D.C. Official Code § 1-309.10(c)) is amended by adding a new
29 paragraph (5) to read as follows:

30 "(5) The Department of Public Works ("DPW") shall give 30-days written notice,
31 excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays, of the intent to remove a public litter container
32 from a public right of way, which shall include a brief description of why DPW believes
33 removing the litter container will improve neighborhood cleanliness and public health, to the
34 OANC, each affected Commission, and the Commissioner representing a single-member district

35 affected by said actions. The notice may be provided by electronic mail, subject to paragraph
36 (1A) of this subsection.”.

37 Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

38 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal
39 impact statement required by section 4aofthe General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975,
40 approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code§ 1-301.47a).

41 Sec. 4. Effective date.

42 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
43 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as
44 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
45 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
46 Columbia Register.
