

AN ACT

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To accept a dedication of land by easement for public space purposes of the portion of W Street, SE, between Railroad Avenue, SE, to the northwest and Shannon Place, SE, to the southeast.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “Dedication of a Portion of W Street, S.E., S.O. 16-24322 Act of 2023”.

Sec. 2. (a) Pursuant to section 302 of the Street and Alley Closing and Acquisition Procedures Act of 1982, effective March 10, 1983 (D.C. Law 4-201; D.C. Official Code § 9-203.02), the Council accepts the dedication of land by easement for public space purposes of the portion of W Street, SE, located between Railroad Avenue, SE, and Shannon Place, SE, as shown on the Surveyor’s Plat in S.O. File 16-24322.

(b) The Council’s acceptance of the dedication of land described in subsection (a) of this section is contingent upon the satisfaction of all conditions set forth in S.O. File 16-24322.

Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

Sec. 4. Effective date.

This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
