- 47 (b) A new subsection (b) is added to read as follows:
 - "(b) The Department of General Services ("DGS") Facilities Management Division, established by the Department of General Services Establishment Act of 2011, shall not close work orders issued for District of Columbia Public School ("DCPS") facilities without affirmative approval from an authorized school representative who concurs that the work has been completed to their satisfaction. For purposes of this section, "authorized school representative" means the principal, building foreman, or other school staff member designated by the principal.".
 - Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.
