IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve, on an emergency basis, Modification Nos. 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, and 13 to Contract No. CW90941 with Aramark Correctional Services, LLC to provide management and operation of the food service program for inmates, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the modifications.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "Modifications to Contract No. CW90941 with Aramark Correctional Services, LLC Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2023".

Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 451 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51), and notwithstanding the requirements of section 202 of the Procurement Practices Reform Act of 2010, effective April 8, 2011 (D.C. Law 18-371; D.C. Official Code § 2-352.02), the Council retroactively approves Modification Nos. 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, and proposed Modification No. 13 to Contract No. CW90941 with Aramark Correctional Services, LLC, to provide food service program for inmates, and authorizes payment in the not-to34 exceed amount of \$6,039,889 for the goods and services received and to be received 35 under the modifications. 36 Sec. 3. The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement provided by the Chief Financial Officer as the fiscal impact statement required by section 4a of the General 37 38 Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. 39 Official Code § 1-301.47a). 40 Sec. 4. This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the 41 event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain 42 in effect for no longer than 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the 43 District of Columbia in section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act,

approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).

Option year one price is 7.4% higher than the price of the base year, reflecting an equitable adjustment and additional labor.

Option Period Two Amount: \$5,833,039 NTE

Explanation of difference from the base period (if applicable): Option year two price is 3.8% higher than the price of the base year, reflecting an increase in inflation (food, labor, and supplies).

Option Period Three Amount: \$5,965,728 NTE

Explanation of difference from the base period (if applicable): Option year three price is 6.1% higher than the price of the base year, reflecting an increase in inflation (food, labor, and supplies).

Option Period Four Amount: \$6,102,415 NTE

Explanation of difference from base period (if applicable): Option year four price is 8.6% higher than the price of the base year, reflecting an increase in inflation (food, labor, and supplies).

(C) The goods or services to be provided, the methods of delivering goods or services, and any significant program changes reflected in the proposed contract:

The Department of Corrections (DOC) has an immediate need for a full-continuum food services contractor to provide management and operation of the food service program for the current estimated average daily population of about 2,100 inmates housed in the District of Columbia's Central Detention Facility at 1901 D Street, SE and the Correctional Treatment Facility located at 1901 E Street, SE.

(D) The selection process, including the number of offerors, the evaluation criteria, and the evaluation results, including price, technical or quality, and past performance components:

The Office of Contracting and Procurement (OCP) on behalf of the DOC issued Request for Proposal Doc547468 to solicit a contractor to provide an inmate food service program and cafeteria-style food service for the officer's dining room at two facilities. Three companies in the correctional food management services business were invited, based on the NIGP commodity code: 9772500, Cafeteria, Food Service, and Kitchen Equipment Rental or Lease.

The three offers were received and evaluated on the evaluation criteria listed in the solicitation:

Technical Approach
Previous Experience/Past Performance
Price Criterion
CBE Preference Points

The contracting officer recommended award to Aramark Correctional Services, LLC (Aramark) as their technical proposal and price proposals were the most advantageous to the District.

(E) A description of any bid protest related to the award of the contract, including whether the protest was resolved through litigation, withdrawal of the protest by the protestor, or voluntary corrective action by the District. Include the identity of the protestor, the grounds alleged in the protest, and any deficiencies identified by the District as a result of the protest:

No protest was received.

(F) The background and qualifications of the proposed contractor, including its organization, financial stability, personnel, and performance on past or current government or private sector contracts with requirements similar to those of the proposed contract:

Aramark Correctional Services, LLC has been a valued partner to the District. They have held multiple contracts for food services to DOC, dating back to 2004. Aramark allows the inmates to continue their education and receive a certification from the National Restaurant Association or Strayer University. Aramark is a strong community partner offering scholarships for post-release inmates, committing to a total of \$10,000 per year in scholarship assistance for graduates interested in continuing their education in food service.

Dun and Bradstreet Risk Manager and Dun and Bradstreet Qualifier report of 8/19/2022 shows Aramark in business for 28 years, since 1994. Aramark has a clear history, secure financing, and a medium risk rating of three, indicating a medium probability of ceasing operations or becoming inactive. The company has earned Dun and Bradstreet's four-and-a-half-star performance rating. The District has an extensive history of contracts with Aramark, all with indicated satisfactory performances.

The contractor has adequate financial resources and reserves to perform the services required under this contract. This is evident in the contractor's financial history, as reported by the Dun and Bradstreet Business Report.

Aramark has a satisfactory record of integrity and business ethics as indicated by the federal excluded parties system search results. The District has no information indicating that Aramark is debarred, suspended, or involved in any activity that would disqualify the company from consideration for contract award due to a lack of integrity and business ethics.

(I) The aggregate dollar value of the proposed changes as compared with the amount of the contract as awarded:

The total contract amount for option year one is \$6,039,889, which is \$315,000 higher than the original option year award amount of \$5,724,889. The increase is due to an equitable adjustment that is based on the increase in food costs.

(J) The date on which the contracting officer was notified of the proposed change:

The contracting officer was aware of the proposed change on August 12, 2022.

(K) The reason why the proposed change was sent to Council for approval after it is intended to take effect:

The District has a continued need to provide food service for DOC residents. Based on rising food costs, on August 12, 2022, Aramark requested that an equitable adjustment be included in the award of option year one. Additional time was needed to negotiate the terms of the equitable adjustment, secure additional funding and obtain a revised subcontracting plan, as well as negotiate the cost of additional staff labor, where the inmate work detail was reduced from 20-25 inmates per shift to six inmates per shift.

(L) The reason for the proposed change:

The District continues to need food service for DOC residents.

The contractor provided a subcontracting plan with a set aside of 35 % with a total dollar amount of \$2,113,961. The contracting officer has determined that the plan meets the Department of Small and Local Business Development's requirements.

Aramark Correctional Services, LLC will continue to provide the DC DOC residents quality food services in accordance with the terms of the contract.
