20	Sec. 2. Alley Closure.
21	Pursuant to Section 201 of the Street and Alley Closing and Acquisition Procedures Act
22	of 1982, effective March 10, 1983 (D.C. Law 4-201; D.C. Official Code § 9-202.01), the Council
23	finds that the 10-foot unimproved public alley in Square 3701 abutting Lots 85 and 88, as shown
24	on the Surveyor's plat filed under S.O. 23-06220, is unnecessary for alley purposes and orders it
25	closed, with title to the land to vest as shown on the Surveyor's plat. The approval of the Council
26	of this alley closing is contingent upon the satisfaction of all the conditions set forth in the
27	official S.O. File 23-06220.
28	Sec. 3. Transmittal.
29	The Secretary to the Council shall transmit a copy of this act, upon its effective date, to
