22	BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
23	act may be cited as the "Fair Motor Vehicle Fines and Penalties Amendment Act of 2024".
24	Sec. 2. The District of Columbia Traffic Adjudication Act of 1978, approved
25	September 12, 1978 (D.C. Law D. 2-104; D.C. Official Code §§50-2301.01 et seq.), is
26	amended as follows:
27	(a) Section 105(a)(2) (D.C. Official Code § 50-2301.01(a)(2)) is amended as follows:
28	(1) Subparagraph (A) is amended by striking the phrase "a penalty equal to the
29	amount of the civil fine;" and replace it with the phrase "\$10;"
30	(2) Subsection (B) is amended striking the phrase "a penalty equal to twice the
31	amount of the civil fine, and with respect to infractions under title III of this act, a penalty
32	equal to the amount of the civil fine plus \$5." and replace it with "a penalty that is no more
33	than \$10, and with respect to infractions under title III of this act, a penalty no more than
34	\$15".

35	(b) Section 205(d) (D.C. Official Code § 50-2302.05(d)) is amended by striking the
36	phrase "equal to the amount of the fine".
