

A BILL IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

1 2 To amend, on a temporary basis, Section 47-4406 of the District of Columbia Official 3 Code to clarify that the Office of Tax and Revenue may furnish tax information to the 4 Department of Licensing and Consumer Protection, for the purposes of implementing the Street 5 Vending Amnesty Program. 6 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this 8 act may be cited as the "Street Vending Amnesty Program Facilitation Temporary Amendment 9 Act of 2024". 10 Sec. 2. Title 47 of the District of Columbia Official Code is amended as follows: 11 (a) Section 47-2002.01(e)(2) is amended by striking the phrase "the Mayor shall certify to 12 the Chief Financial Officer" and inserting the phrase "the Office of the Chief Financial Officer 13 shall certify to the Department of Licensing and Consumer Protection" in its place. 14 (b) Section 47-4406 is amended as follows: 15 (1) Subsection (a) is amended by striking the phrase "(e-1), and (e-2) of this section" and 16 inserting the phrase "(e-1), (e-2), and (e-3) of this section" in its place. 17 (2) A new subsection (e-3) is added to read as follows: 18 "(e-3) The Office of Tax and Revenue may furnish, upon request of the Department of 19 Licensing and Consumer Protection, information necessary to implement the street vending

- 21 1, 2023 (D.C. Law 25-21, D.C. Official Code § 37-131.08c)."

- 27 (a) This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by
- 28 the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review
- as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
- 30 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
- 31 Columbia Register.
- 32 (b) This act shall expire after 225 days of its having taken effect.
