9 10	To amend the Department of Transportation Establishment Act of 2002 to provide the Director
10	of the District Department of Transportation Establishment Act of 2002 to provide the Director of the District Department of Transportation ("DDOT") with greater discretion to
12	delegate the agency's duties and responsibilities, to provide the DDOT Director with the
13	authority to construct, maintain, and control DDOT infrastructure on land transferred
14	from the federal government for recreational purposes in cases where the land transferred
15 16	is adjacent to public space and is part of a transportation improvement plan or project, and to provide that the District has an adequate interest sufficient to meet federal highway
17	funding requirements in federal parkland where transportation infrastructure projects are
18	located; and to amend the Vision Zero Enhancement Omnibus Amendment Act of 2020
19	to provide the Director of DDOT with greater discretion to delegate the agency's duties
20	and responsibilities.

22	BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
23	act may be cited as the "Transportation Improvements Amendment Act of 2024".
24	Sec. 2. The Department of Transportation Establishment Act of 2002, effective May 21,
25	2002 (D.C. Law 14-137; D.C. Official Code § 50–921.01 et seq.), is amended as follows:
26	(a) Section 4 (D.C. Official Code § 50-921.03) is repealed.
27	(b) Section 5(a) (D.C. Official Code § 50-921.04(a)) is amended as follows:
28	(1) The lead-in language is amended by striking the phrase "The offices of DDOT
29	shall" and inserting the phrase "DDOT shall" in its place.
30	(2) Paragraph (1) is amended as follows:

31	(A) The lead-in language is amended by striking the phrase "The Project
32	Delivery Administration shall" and inserting the phrase "Pursuant to its responsibility for
33	transportation project delivery, DDOT shall" in its place.
34	(B) Subparagraph (A) is amended to read as follows:
35	"(A) Identify transportation needs of the District and design, manage, and
36	implement transportation improvement plans and projects, including design, engineering, and
37	related support;".
38	(C) Subparagraph (P) is amended by striking the phrase "on mass transit
39	needs" and inserting the phrase "on transit policy, mass transit, and alternative transit needs" in
40	its place.
41	(D) Subparagraph (U) is amended by striking the phrase "; and" and
42	inserting a semicolon in its place.
43	(E) Subparagraph (V) is amended by striking the period and inserting a
44	semicolon in its place.
45	(F) New subparagraphs (W) and (X) are added to read as follows:
46	"(W) Carry out duties related to freight and passenger rail, to the extent
47	such authority has been delegated or required by federal law, and duties relating to State
48	Transportation Environmental Compliance; and
49	"(X) Manage, control, and implement transportation improvement plans
50	and projects on land transferred from the federal government for recreational use

51	pursuant to 40 U.S.C. § 8124 and section 1 of An Act To authorize the transfer of jurisdiction
52	over public land in the District of Columbia, approved May 20, 1932 (47 Stat. 161;
53	D.C. Official Code § 10-111), in cases where the land transferred is adjacent to public space and
54	is part of a transportation improvement plan or project.".
55	(3) Paragraph (2) is amended by striking the phrase "The Project Delivery
56	Administration may" and inserting the word "DDOT may" in its place.
57	(4) Paragraph (3) is amended as follows:
58	(A) The lead-in language is amended by striking the phrase "The
59	Operations Administration shall" and inserting the phrase "Pursuant to its responsibility for
60	transportation operations, DDOT shall" in its place.
61	(B) Subparagraph (G) is amended by striking the phrase "transportation
62	system infrastructure" and inserting the phrase "transportation infrastructure and maintain all
63	DDOT assets" in its place.
64	(5) Paragraph (4) is amended to read as follows:
65	"(4) Pursuant to its responsibility for agency administration, DDOT shall:
66	"(A) Perform financial planning, financial management, and budgeting
67	activities;
68	"(B) Perform functions relating to workforce development and the
69	management of human resources;

70	"(C) Support the contracting and procurement of goods and services
71	required to fulfill DDOT's functions; and
72	"(D) Manage DDOT's fleet, warehouses, and other facilities.".
73	(6) Paragraph (5) is amended as follows:
74	(A) The lead-in language is amended by striking the phrase "The
75	Performance Administration shall" and inserting the phrase "Pursuant to its responsibility for
76	ensuring adequate performance of the other duties identified in this section, DDOT shall" in its
77	place.
78	(B) A new subparagraph (E) is added to read as follows:
79	"(E) Provide customer service.".
80	(7) New paragraphs (6) and (7) are added to read as follows:
81	"(6) The Director shall designate DDOT staff who are responsible for:
82	"(A) Providing legal counsel;
83	"(B) Civil rights matters;
84	"(C) Compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990,
85	approved July 26, 1990 (104 Stat. 327; 42 U.S.C. § 12101 et seq.);
86	"(D) Senior and elderly affairs; and
87	"(E) Policy and legislative affairs.

88	"(7) The Director shall establish such offices and divisions as, in the Director's
89	judgment, are appropriate to efficiently and soundly administer DDOT's various
90	responsibilities.".
91	(c) A new section 9t is added to read as follows:
92	"Sec. 9t. Adequate interest for transportation projects on National Park Service parkland.
93	"(a) When public roads and bridges on National Park Service ("NPS") parkland entrusted
94	to the Mayor by Congress or NPS are in need of reconstruction or maintenance, the authority
95	given to the Mayor pursuant to section 2 of An act for the government of the District of
96	Columbia, and for other purposes, approved June 20, 1874 (18 Stat. 116; D.C. Official Code § 9-
97	101.02), shall be deemed to be an interest adequate to fulfill the purpose of the project within the
98	meaning of Title 23 of the U.S. Code or another applicable federal law.
99	"(b) Pursuant to subsection (a) of this section, the Mayor is authorized to operate and
100	maintain those public roads and bridges, including associated infrastructure, subject to applicable
101	permits from the National Park Service.".
102	Sec. 3. Section 4(a) of the Vision Zero Enhancement Omnibus Amendment Act of 2020,
103	effective December 23, 2020 (D.C. Law 23-158; 67 DCR 13057), is amended as follows:
104	(a) Amended paragraph (2A) within paragraph (1) is amended by striking the phrase
105	"The Project Delivery Administration shall" and inserting the word "DDOT shall" in its place.
106	(b) Amended paragraph (3A) within paragraph (2) is amended by striking the phrase
107	"The Operations Administration shall" and inserting the word "DDOT shall" in its place.

108	(c) Amended paragraph (5) within paragraph (3) is amended as follows:
109	(1) Amended subparagraph (C)(ii) is amended by striking the period and inserting
110	a semicolon in its place.

114	The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal
115	impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975,
116	approved October 16, 1975 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).
117	Sec 5. Effective date.
118	This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
119	Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as
120	provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
121	24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1).
