17	act may be cited as the "Special Education for Young Adults in the Custody of the Department of
18	Corrections Temporary Amendment Act of 2024".
19	Sec. 2. Section 2(b) of An Act To create a Department of Corrections in the District of
20	Columbia, approved June 27, 1946 (60 Stat. 320; D.C. Official Code § 24-211.02(b)), is
21	amended as follows:
22	(a) Paragraph (9) is amended by striking the phrase "; and" and inserting a semicolon in
23	its place.
24	(b) The first paragraph (10) is amended by striking the period and inserting a semicolon
25	in its place.
26	(c) The second paragraph is redesignated as paragraph (11).
27	(d) The newly redesignated paragraph (11) is amended by striking the period and
28	inserting the phrase "; and" in its place.

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29	(e) A new paragraph (12) is added to read as follows:
30	"(12) During school year 2023-2024, provide a free appropriate public education
31	("FAPE") under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, approved April 13, 1970 (84
32	Stat. 175; 20 U.S.C. § 1400 et seq.) ("IDEA"), and District law, to individuals with disabilities
33	who are in its custody and detained in its secure facilities from the age of 18 through the end of
34	the individual's eligibility for FAPE under the IDEA and District law.".

56	1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(2)).
