IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

---

To designate the public alley system within Square 6153, Lots 84 and 85, located at 3929-3931 4<sup>th</sup> Street, SE, close to the intersection 4<sup>th</sup> Street SE and Atlantic Street, SE, in Ward 8 as Ida B. Wells Alley.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “Ida B. Wells Alley Designation Act of 2024”.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to sections 401, 403, and 421 of the Street and Alley Closing and Acquisitions Procedures Act of 1982, effective March 10, 1983 (D.C. Law 4-201; D.C. Official Code §§ 9-204.01, 9-204.03, and 9-204.21), the Council designates the public alley system within Square 6153, bounded by 4<sup>th</sup> Street SE and Atlantic Street SE, as depicted by the plat in the committee report, as “Ida B. Wells Alley”.

Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

Sec. 4. Effective date.

This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as
