17	BE IT ENACTED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
18	act may be cited as the "Eid al-Fitr Day Amendment Act of 2024".
19	Section 2. § 1202(a) of the District of Columbia Government Comprehensive Merit
20	Personnel Act of 1978, effective March 3, 1979 (D.C. Law 2-139; D.C. Official Code § 1-
21	612.02(a)), is amended by adding a new paragraph (12) to read as follows:
22	"(12) Eid al-Fitr, on the first day of Shawwal, the month following Ramadan, according
23	to the Islamic lunar calendar;".
24	Section 3. § 28-2701 of the District of Columbia Official Code is amended by striking the phrase
25	"April 16; Memorial Day, the last Monday in May;" and inserting the phrase "April 16; Eid al-Fitr, the
26	first day of Shawwal, the month following Ramadan, according to the Islamic lunar calendar; Memorial
27	Day, the last Monday in May;" in its place.
28	Section 4. Fiscal impact statement.
29 30	The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal
31	impact statement required by section 602(c)(3) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act,
32	approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(3)).
33	Section 5. Effective date.
