Metropolitan Area 17 of the District of Columbia. 18 19 WHEREAS, September 15, 1821 is the independence and proclamation of the sovereignty of El Salvador; and, marks this nation's 194th Independence anniversary. 20 21 WHEREAS, the Salvadorian community is the largest Latino group concentrated in the 22 D.C. Metropolitan Area; and, stands as the second largest concentration of Salvadorians 23 living in the diaspora. 24 WHEREAS, Ward One and our entire city welcomes, encourages, promotes and 25 facilitates broad and inclusive civic participation and cultural diversity. 26 WHEREAS, Salvadorians around the world celebrate this anniversary with festivals that 27 help unite Salvadorians, Latin Americans and a wealth of all kinds of communities in our 28 area by exposing the Salvadorian culture, fold, cuisine, arts and more, which are part of 29 their heritage and ours; and, RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this 30 31 resolution may be cited as "El Salvador Independence Day Recognition Resolution of 32 2014".

- 2 as the Independence Day of El Salvador. And, in unity with Salvadorians, its
- 3 government, its visiting governmental representatives, Latin American families,
- 4 organizers and participants of all sorts of events across the area, we honor the
- 5 contributions of Salvadorians make every day to our city, the D.C. Metropolitan Area and
- 6 our nation.
